1. ITEMS FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

1. Consideration and Possible Approval of an Order Canvassing the returns and declaring the results of a Special Bond Election held on May 3, 2025

Adopt the ordinance canvassing the May 3, 2025 Special Election results.

Councilmember Dutton made a motion to approve the ordinance. Councilmember Hedrick seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion carried.

2. Consider Approval of an Ordinance Canvassing and Declaring the Results of the General Election for Mayor and City Councilmembers for Districts 3, 6, 7, and 8 held on May 3, 2025 and Issue Certificates of Election to the Newly Elected Councilmembers

Adopt the ordinance canvassing the May 3, 2025 General Election results.

Councilmember Hedrick made a motion to approve the ordinance. Mayor Pro Tem Moore seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion carried.

3. Call a Runoff Election Pursuant to Ordinance No. 7568 and the May 3, 2025 General Election Results

Call a runoff election to be held on June 7, 2025 for the purpose of electing a Mayor, as no candidate received a majority of the votes cast in the May 3, 2025 General Election; providing for the conduct and administration of the election in accordance with applicable laws; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Lucht made a motion to approve the ordinance. Councilmember Williams seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion carried.

4. Conduct Swearing in Ceremony

Conduct swearing in ceremony to the newly elected members of the City Council of the City of Garland, Texas, following the May 3, 2025 General Election.

The following Councilmembers were sworn in: Councilmember Ed Moore representing District 3, Councilmember Carissa Dutton representing District 6, Councilmember Joe Thomas Jr. representing District 7, and Councilmember Chris Ott representing District 8.
