CITY OF GARLAND SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The Garland City Council extends to all visitors a sincere welcome. We value your interest in our community and your participation in the meetings of this governing body. Visit GarlandTX.gov/Council for a full list of meeting dates.

The Council Chambers at Garland City Hall is wheelchair accessible, and ADA parking is available on the street as well as in the public parking garage. Persons with disabilities who may need auxiliary aids or services must contact the City Secretary's Office at 972-205-2404 at least two working days prior to the meeting so that appropriate arrangements can be made. Braille is not available.

NOTICE: Pursuant to Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, one or more members of the City Council may attend this meeting by internet/video remote means. A quorum of the City Council, as well as the presiding officer, will be physically present at the above-identified location. Members of the public that desire to make a public comment must attend the meeting in person.

ITEMS FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

Members of the audience may provide public comment in favor, in opposition or about any of the items for individual consideration. Anyone wishing to speak must fill out a speaker card (located at the entrance to the Council Chambers) and give it to the City Secretary in advance of the respective agenda item. Speakers are grouped by agenda item and will be called in the order of the agenda. All comments and testimony are to be presented from the podium. The Mayor may impose a time limit and may provide for rebuttal.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Members of the audience wishing to address issues not on the meeting agenda may have three minutes to speak. However, according to the Texas Open Meetings Act, Council is prohibited from discussing any item not on the posted agenda.

ADJOURN

All Regular Meetings of the Garland City Council are broadcast live on CGTV, Time Warner Cable Channel 16 and Frontier FIOS TV 44. Meetings are rebroadcast at 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. Wednesdays - Sundays. Live streaming and on-demand videos of the meetings are also available online at GarlandTX.tv. Copies of the meetings can be purchased through the City Secretary's Office (audio CD's are \$1 each and DVD's are \$3 each).

NOTICE: The City Council may recess from the open session and convene in a closed executive session if the discussion of any of the listed agenda items concerns one or more of the following matters:

1. Pending/contemplated litigation, settlement offer(s), and matters concerning privileged and unprivileged client information deemed confidential by Rule 1.05 of the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct. Sec. 551.071, Tex. Gov't Code.
2. The purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. Sec. 551.072, Tex. Gov't Code.
3. A contract for a prospective gift or donation to the City, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. Sec. 551.073, Tex. Gov't Code.
4. Personnel matters involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee. Sec. 551.074, Tex. Gov't Code.
5. The deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices. Sec. 551.076, Tex. Gov't Code.
6. Discussions or deliberations regarding commercial or financial information that the City has received from a business prospect that the City seeks to have to locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the City and with which the City is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect of the sort described in this provision. Sec. 551.087, Tex. Gov't Code.
7. Discussions, deliberations, votes, or other final action on matters related to the City's competitive activity, including information that would, if disclosed, give advantage to competitors or prospective competitors and is reasonably related to one or more of the following categories of information:
 - generation unit specific and portfolio fixed and variable costs, including forecasts of those costs, capital improvement plans for generation units, and generation unit operating characteristics and outage scheduling;
 - bidding and pricing information for purchased power, generation, and fuel, and Electric Reliability Council of Texas bids, prices, offers, and related services and strategies;
 - effective fuel and purchased power agreements and fuel transportation arrangements and contracts;
 - risk management information, contracts, and strategies, including fuel hedging and storage;
 - plans, studies, proposals, and analyses for system improvements, additions, or sales, other than transmission and distribution system improvements inside the service area for which the public power utility is the sole certificated retail provider; and
 - customer billing, contract, and usage information, electric power pricing information, system load characteristics, and electric power marketing analyses and strategies. Sec. 551.086; Tex. Gov't Code; Sec. 552.133, Tex. Gov't Code]

Issue / Summary

Adopt the ordinance canvassing the May 2, 2026 General Election results and issuing certificates of election to the newly elected councilmembers.

Background

The City of Garland held a General Election on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing a City Councilmember to represent District 5. In addition, certain Councilmembers were previously declared elected on February 17, 2026, as unopposed candidates in accordance with the Texas Election Code. State law requires the governing body to canvass the election results and officially declare the outcomes. Following canvassing, Certificates of Election must be issued to all duly elected Councilmembers. At the time of posting the agenda, the unofficial election results had not been received from Dallas County Elections Department. Handouts will be provided at the City Council meeting on May 2, 2026.

Consideration / Recommendation

Approve an ordinance canvassing and declaring the results of the May 2, 2026 General Election for City Councilmember, District 5, and authorize the issuance of Certificates of Election to the newly elected Councilmembers, including those declared elected on February 17, 2026.

ORDINANCE NO. 7653

AN ORDINANCE CANCELING THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD MAY 2, 2026, FOR UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR COUNCILMEMBERS FOR DISTRICTS 1, 2, AND 4; DECLARING EACH OF THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR COUNCILMEMBERS WITHIN THOSE RESPECTIVE DISTRICTS ELECTED TO OFFICE; ORDERING THE CITY SECRETARY TO POST A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE AT EACH POLLING PLACE THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN USED IN THE ELECTION; CONTINUING AS UNAFFECTED BY THIS ORDINANCE THE ELECTION FOR COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT 5; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2026, the City Council ordered a general election to be held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Districts 1, 2, 4, and 5;

WHEREAS, the election is for officers of the City in which write-in votes may be counted only for names appearing on a list of write-in candidates and in which each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed;

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and for declaration of write-in candidacy have passed;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council have received the City Secretary's written certification that each of the candidates for Councilmember for District 1, District 2, and District 4 are unopposed, a copy of which certification is attached hereto;

WHEREAS, in these circumstances, Chapter 2, Subchapter C of the Texas Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and to cancel the election, thereby avoiding unnecessary expense; and

WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 1 of the Garland City Charter mandates that elections in such circumstances must be canceled;

WHEREAS, three candidates duly and timely filed as candidates for Councilmember for District 5 thereby making this ordinance inapplicable to the election called for electing a Councilmember for District 5;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1

That the general election for the purpose of electing for Districts 1, 2, and 4 is hereby canceled.

Section 2

That the following candidates, who are unopposed for the May 2, 2026, general election are hereby declared elected to the respective office described below, subject to the issuance of a certificate of election and their taking the oath of office for the position and for the term to which they are hereby declared to be elected:

Councilmember, District 1: Jimmy Tran

Councilmember, District 2: Justin Caraway

Councilmember, District 4: Christina Segoviano

Section 3

That the City Secretary shall post a copy of this Ordinance at City Hall and at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

Section 4

That nothing contained in this Ordinance shall affect the election for Councilmember for District 5, and such election shall continue in all respects as provided by law.

Section 5

That this Ordinance shall be and become effective upon its passage and approval.

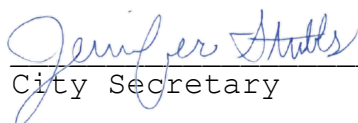

MỘT SẮC LỆNH HỦY BỎ CUỘC TỔNG TUYỂN CỬ DỰ KIẾN TỔ CHỨC VÀO NGÀY 2 THÁNG 5 NĂM 2026 ĐỐI VỚI CÁC ỨNG CỬ VIÊN KHÔNG CÓ ĐỐI THỦ CHO CHỨC DANH THÀNH VIÊN HỘI ĐỒNG THÀNH PHỐ TẠI CÁC QUẬN SỐ 1, 2 VÀ 4; TUYÊN BỐ CÁC ỨNG CỬ VIÊN KHÔNG CÓ ĐỐI THỦ TẠI CÁC ĐƠN VỊ NÊU TRÊN TRÚNG CỬ; CHỈ ĐẠO THƯ KÝ THÀNH PHỐ NIÊM YẾT BẢN SAO SẮC LỆNH NÀY TẠI MỖI ĐIỂM BỎ PHIẾU ĐÃ DỰ KIẾN SỬ DỤNG CHO CUỘC BẦU CỬ; TIẾP TỤC TỔ CHỨC CUỘC BẦU CỬ CHỨC DANH THÀNH VIÊN HỘI ĐỒNG THÀNH PHỐ ĐƠN VỊ SỐ 5 KHÔNG BỊ ẢNH HƯỞNG BỞI SẮC LỆNH NÀY; VÀ QUY ĐỊNH NGÀY CÓ HIỆU LỰC.

XÉT RẰNG, vào ngày 3 tháng 2 năm 2026, Hội đồng Thành phố đã ban hành quyết định tổ chức một cuộc tổng tuyển cử vào ngày 2 tháng 5 năm 2026 nhằm mục đích bầu ra Thành viên Hội đồng Thành phố cho các Quận số 1, 2, 4 và 5;

XÉT RẰNG, đây là cuộc bầu cử đối với các chức danh của Thành phố, trong đó phiếu bầu ghi thêm chỉ được kiểm đếm đối với những tên có trong danh sách ứng cử viên ghi thêm, và mỗi ứng cử viên có tên trên lá phiếu đều không có đối thủ cạnh tranh;

XÉT RẰNG, thời hạn nộp hồ sơ để được ghi tên trên lá phiếu cũng như thời hạn tuyên bố ứng cử theo hình thức ghi thêm đã hết;

XÉT RẰNG, Thị trưởng và Hội đồng Thành phố đã nhận được văn bản chứng nhận của Thư ký Thành phố xác nhận rằng mỗi ứng cử viên cho chức danh Thành viên Hội đồng Thành phố tại Quận 1, Quận 2 và Quận 4 đều không có đối thủ cạnh tranh; bản sao chứng nhận đó được đính kèm theo đây;

XÉT RẰNG, trong các trường hợp như vậy, Chương 2, Tiểu mục C của Bộ luật Bầu cử Texas cho phép cơ quan điều hành tuyên bố các ứng cử viên không có đối thủ đương nhiên trúng cử và hủy bỏ cuộc bầu cử nhằm tránh các chi phí không cần thiết; và

XÉT RẰNG, Điều XII, Mục 1 của Hiến chương Thành phố Garland quy định bắt buộc phải hủy bỏ cuộc bầu cử trong các trường hợp như vậy;

XÉT RẰNG, có ba ứng cử viên đã nộp hồ sơ hợp lệ và đúng thời hạn cho chức danh Thành viên Hội đồng Thành phố tại Quận 5, do đó sắc lệnh này không áp dụng đối với cuộc bầu cử được triệu tập để bầu Thành viên Hội đồng Thành phố cho Quận 5;

VÌ VẬY, NAY HỘI ĐỒNG THÀNH PHỐ THÀNH PHỐ GARLAND, TEXAS, BAN HÀNH QUY ĐỊNH:

Mục 1

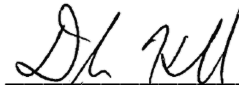

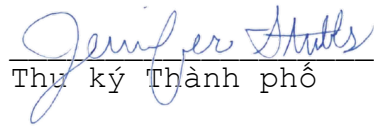

DECRETO QUE CANCELA LA ELECCIÓN GENERAL PROGRAMADA PARA EL 2 DE MAYO DE 2026, DE CANDIDATOS ÚNICOS AL PUESTO DE CONCEJAL PARA LOS DISTRITOS 1, 2, Y 4; Y QUE DECLARA ELEGIDO A CADA UNO DE LOS CANDIDATOS ÚNICOS AL PUESTO DE CONCEJAL PARA LOS DISTRITOS RESPECTIVOS; QUE ORDENA A LA SECRETARIA MUNICIPAL FIJAR UNA COPIA DE ESTA DECRETO EN CADA LUGAR DE VOTACIÓN QUE SE HUBIERA EMPLEADO EN LA ELECCIÓN; ESTE DECRETO NO AFECTA O CANCELA LA ELECCIÓN DE UN CONCEJAL PARA EL DISTRITO 5; Y ESTABLECE UNA FECHA DE VIGENCIA.

POR CUANTO, el día 3 de febrero de 2026, el Consejo Municipal ordenó que se realice una elección general el día 2 de mayo de 2026, con el propósito de elegir Concejales para los Distritos 1, 2, 4, y 5;

POR CUANTO, la elección es de funcionarios de la Ciudad en la que los votos para candidatos no registrados solo pueden contabilizarse en el caso de nombres que aparecen en una lista de candidatos no registrados; y en la que cada candidato cuyo nombre aparece en la papeleta de votación no tiene oposición;

POR CUANTO, ya han pasado las fechas máximas para inclusión en la papeleta de votación y la declaración de una candidatura no registrada;

POR CUANTO, el Alcalde y el Consejo Municipal han recibido la certificación escrita de la Secretaria Municipal de que cada uno de los candidatos a Concejal para el Distrito 1, Distrito 2 y Distrito 4 es candidato único, adjuntándose a la presente una copia de dicha certificación;

POR CUANTO, bajo dichas circunstancias, el Capítulo 2, Subcapítulo C del Código Electoral de Texas autoriza a un organismo rector declarar como elegido al cargo a cada uno de los candidatos sin oposición, y cancelar la elección, evitando de esta manera cualquier gasto innecesario; y

POR CUANTO, el Artículo XII, Sección 1 de la Carta Constitutiva de la Ciudad de Garland obliga la cancelación de elecciones bajo dichas circunstancias;

POR CUANTO, tres candidatos presentaron debida y oportunamente su candidatura a Concejal para el Distrito 5, por lo tanto este decreto no se aplica a la elección convocada para elegir un Concejal para el Distrito 5;

POR LO TANTO, ORDENE EL CONSEJO MUNICIPAL DE LA CIUDAD DE GARLAND, TEXAS:

Sección 1

Que por la presente queda cancelada la elección general para elegir Concejales para los Distritos 1, 2 y 4.

Sección 2

Que los candidatos a continuación, siendo candidatos únicos en la elección general del 2 de mayo de 2026, son declarados debidamente elegidos a sus cargos respectivos descritos a continuación, sujeto a la emisión de un certificado de elección y la prestación del juramento oficial del cargo, y para el plazo para el cual se les declara elegidos:

Sección 3

Sección 5

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CANDIDATE TO THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL FOR COUNCILMEMBER TO DISTRICT 5 OF THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS, FOR THE ELECTION HELD ON MAY 2, 2026; DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THAT ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on the 12th of May, 2026, such date being within the time prescribed by law for the canvassing of election results at an election called by a municipality, the City Council canvassed the results of the general election held on the 2nd day of May, 2026, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers to Districts 1, 2, 4, and 5 of the City of Garland, Texas; such election having been duly ordered by the City Council under the authority of the Constitution and laws of the State;
